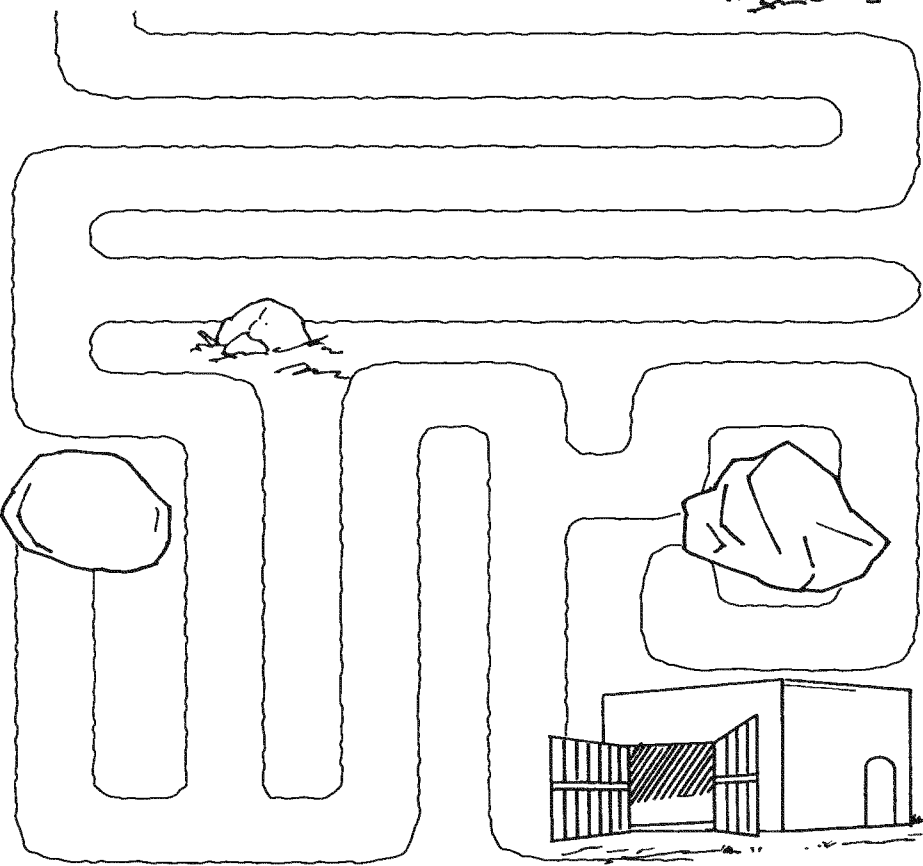


The owner of the field said,

 wheat to the barn.

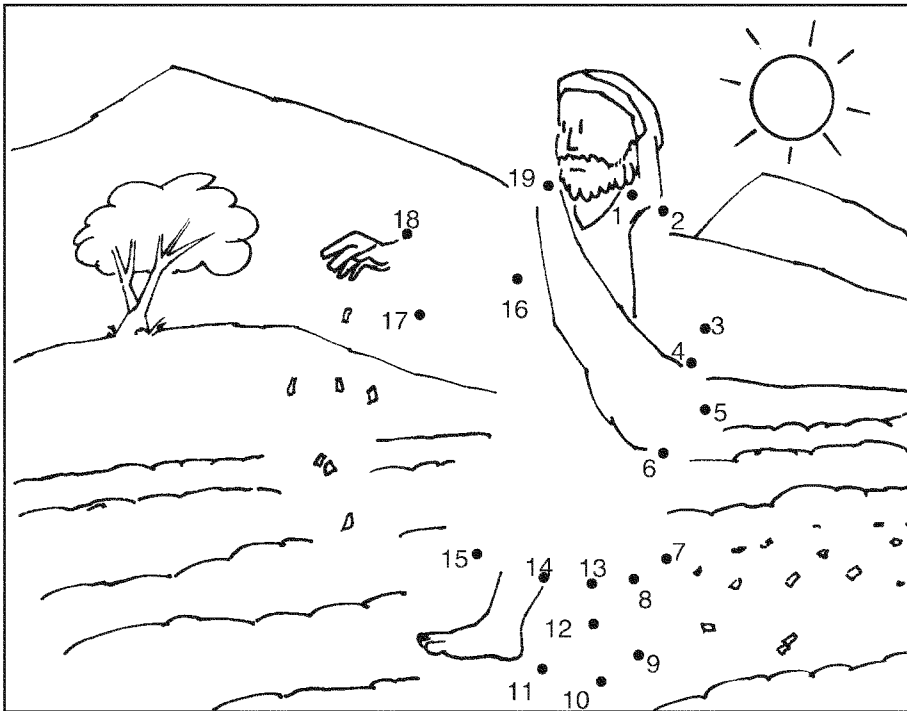

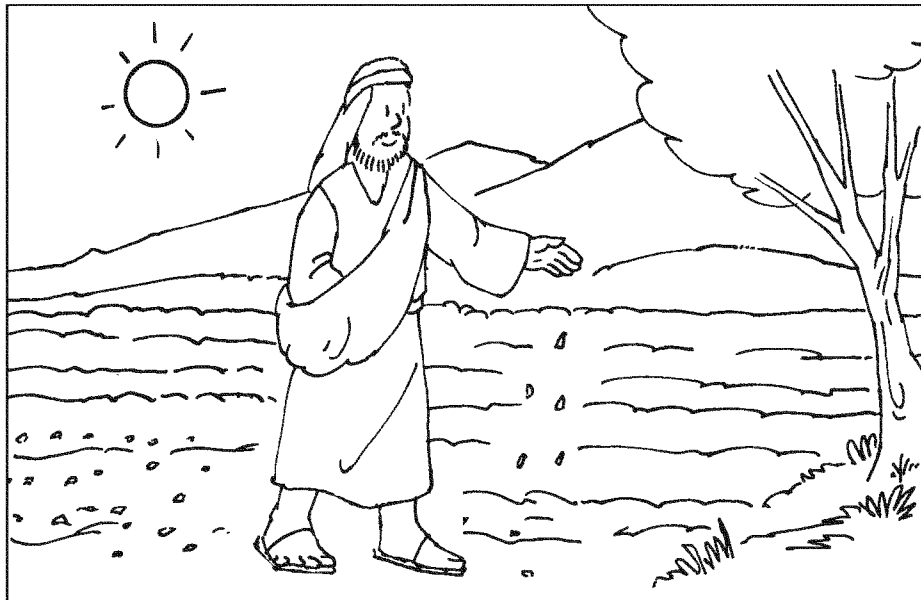
